Dear ATJC Families,

As the High Holidays approach, we are eager to—once again—provide meaningful and creative ways to safely pray, reconnect and be together. In Hebrew, these days are known as *Y'mei Teshuva* ("Days of Repentance"). But *Teshuva* also means "Return." After 18 months of this ongoing pandemic now surging in our region, we remain committed to you during this "Season of Return" and beyond. However you choose to connect with ATJC over the High Holidays, we pray that everyone will be inspired by our various experiences and be able to "return" to some sense of normalcy.

Here are our High Holiday guidelines for safely praying, connecting and returning together:

- **Vaccinated members are welcome at all indoor and outdoor services**
- **Children under 12 are welcome at all outdoor services**
- **Masks covering nose and mouth are required at all indoor and outdoor services (over age 2)**
- **Social distancing will be provided at all assigned and open seating**
- **Babysitting will not be provided**
- **Valet Parking will be provided**
- **Services will be live streamed on YouTube, Facebook and our Website ([www.atjc.org](http://www.atjc.org))**
- **To maintain social distancing, Bimah honors are for one household at a time. As such, we are unable to have large groups on the Bimah at any single time.**

These protocols represent the most up-to-date recommendations of our ATJC COVID-19 Response Task Force which includes medical professionals and current CDC guidelines. They are subject to change. If you have any questions, please reach out to us at the synagogue office.

We hope you will carefully review the High Holiday program information and choose to join us in-person or online at any or all of the experiences that fit your level of comfort.

May the New Year bless us and the entire world with good health, peace and prosperity. Thank you for being a part of our sacred community.
